THE PRESENT 2023 PALESTINIAN & ISRAELI CONFLICT

Based on the Bible, We Ask, "What Is a Christian to Think?"

PART A

BY WAY OF INTRODUCTION: THE BIBLICAL BACKGROUND & TONE

1. Like the present Palestinians and Israelis, the ongoing history of *nations* revolves around the "blessing/curse" motif of Scripture (cp. Deuteronomy 28).

This contrasting motif is set into motion in one of two ways. EITHER nations & individuals repent with Godly sorrow toward sin and then trust in Christ for forgiveness OR they reject Jesus, refuse to repent, and thereby endorse Satan's ways of sin and unbelief. This leaves such non-Christians to depend on their own efforts or good works to save them eternally.

The majority of both Palestinians [*Muslims*] and Israelis [*Jews*] endorse such salvation by works, <u>not</u> by faith in Christ. In Galatians 3:5-11 the apostle Paul <u>asks</u> his audience:

...does God supply you with the Spirit and work miracles among you by your doing what the Law says, or by believing what you are hearing?

Abraham is a good example: He believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness. (See Genesis 15:6.) You see, then, that those who believe are Abraham's real sons, that is, since the Scripture foresaw that God would justify [acquit] the nations by faith.

He announced the Gospel to Abraham <u>beforehand</u>, saying: "Through you [Abraham] all nations will be <u>blessed</u> [that is, because <u>Jesus</u> was to come from Abraham's genealogy]." Paul then continues by saying, "So those who believe are <u>blessed</u> together with Abraham, a man of faith."

The apostle now spells out the <u>contrast</u>: "There is a <u>curse</u> on all <u>who depend on doing</u> what the <u>Law</u> says, because it is written: "Cursed is everyone who does <u>not</u> continue to do <u>everything</u> written in the book of the Law." It is clear that **no one** is <u>justified</u> [declared righteous] before **God** by doing what the <u>Law</u> says, because the <u>just</u> [the ones declared righteous] will live by <u>faith</u>."

Now let's consider God's promise of "blessings or curses" on the nations
In Genesis 12:3a GOD predicted: "I will bless those who bless you, and in you
[Abraham] all the people in the world will be blessed" (cp. 2 Corinthians 5:15).
Genesis 12:3b: Then GOD also predicted: "I will...curse anyone who curses you
[Abraham, that is, who does not believe in your eventual Offspring, Jesus],...."

At this point biblical truth-seekers need to remember the words of John the Baptizer as he spoke to *unbelieving* Jews in **Matthew 3:9**: He said: "Do not think that you can tell yourselves, 'Abraham is <u>our</u> father.' For I tell you, GOD can raise up children for Abraham from these stones," meaning that *unbelieving* Jews could <u>not</u> be saved since they were <u>not</u> **SPIRITUAL** sons and daughters of Abraham nor of GOD.

Point in fact, <u>neither</u> <u>unbelieving</u> <u>Muslims</u> nor <u>Jews</u> in the present <u>Palestinian & Israeli</u> Conflict are to be favored <u>SPIRITUALLY</u> by <u>Christians</u>. Individuals from both groups can only be saved by the <u>Holy Spirit</u> through <u>Christian</u> evangelism. They cannot be saved for eternity by our <u>emotions</u> <u>OR</u> by our <u>cultural and political</u> preferences. This is a hard truth that will be expanded-on in our <u>4-PART</u> study. So hang on, here we go!!!

- 2. Tension between *Islam* and *Judaism* from the time of Muhammad (AD 570-632) until today has played-out over-and-over again. (PART D of our study will contend that *Islam* is the "political" Antichrist of Revelation 13:1-12 and that *Jews* will still be around to be saved until the end of time (Isaiah 66:20-22).
- 3. Barack Obama's take on things, as quoted from the Internet (November 5, 2023): "Nobody's hands are clean." **Giessler: GOD** protects Christians against unbelieving Muslims & Jews by often pitting these Muslims & Jews against one another in order to protect Christians from slaughter.
- The **Balford Declaration** of 1917: The **Balfour Declaration** was a public statement issued by the British government in 1917 during the <u>First World War</u> announcing its support for the establishment of a "national home for the Jewish people" in <u>Palestine</u>,.... The declaration had many long-lasting consequences. It greatly increased popular support for **Zionism** within <u>Jewish communities worldwide</u>, and became a core component of the <u>British Mandate for Palestine</u>, the founding document of <u>Mandatory Palestine</u>. It indirectly led to the emergence of <u>Israel</u> and is considered a principal cause of the ongoing <u>Israeli–Palestinian conflict</u>, often described as the world's most <u>ongoing conflict</u>. Controversy remains over a number of areas, such as whether the declaration contradicted earlier promises the British made to <u>the Sharif of Mecca</u> in the McMahon–Hussein correspondence.
- The **EXODUS** The Ship that Launched a Nation
 The story of the **Exodus**, the ship that carried 4,500 Jewish refugees from Europe to Palestine in 1947, summarizes the essence of Israel's creation a journey, an exodus, from the hellish depths of the Holocaust to independence and nationhood.
- What is "Zionism"? From Wikpedia: "Zionism (derived from the name <u>Zion</u>) is a <u>nationalist</u> movement that emerged in the 19th century to enable the establishment of a <u>homeland for the Jewish people in Palestine</u>, a region roughly corresponding to the <u>Land of Israel</u> in <u>Jewish tradition</u>. Following the <u>establishment of Israel</u>, **Zionism** became an ideology that supports 'the development and protection of the State of Israel.'"

7. American policy based on a *false* assumption: Exegesis of Genesis 12:1-3:

The LORD said to Abram, "Leave your land, your relatives, and your father's home, and go to a *land* I will show you. I will make you a *great nation*. I will *bless* you and give you a great name, and you will be a *blessing*. I will *bless* those who *bless* you [Abraham], and *curse* anyone who *curses* you [Abraham], and in you all the people in the world will be *blessed*."

A comment on Genesis 22:18: The pre-incarnate Christ said to Abraham, "In your Descendant <u>all</u> the <u>people</u> on earth will be <u>blessed</u>." (This explains Paul's Galatians 3:16 conclusion.)

As we shall see in **#8.** below, the **unbelieving** Jews of Jesus's day <u>and onward</u> are under the curse of Genesis 12:3b—and the land <u>no longer belongs to them</u>, in fact, the land of the whole world now belongs to Christians (cp. Matthew 28:19: "baptize all nations"), nations who by faith in Jesus can be covered by the blessing of forgiveness.

- 3. Understand that **Matthew 23**:37-39 is spoken *against* the *Jewish spiritual* leaders! (**Note** the seven [7] repeats of the statement by **Jesus** where in verses 13-29 **He** says, "**WOE** to you, *scribes* and *Pharisees*!")
 - In Matthew 23:33-35a, 36: Jesus said: "You snakes! Brood of poisonous snakes! How can you escape being condemned to hell? That is why I am sending you prophets, wise men, and teachers of the Scriptures [that is, to tell you that you are condemned to hell]. You will kill and crucify some of them. Others you will whip in your synagogs and persecute from town to town. In this way all the innocent blood shed on the earth will come upon you, I tell you the truth, all these things will come upon this generation. (This was initially fulfilled when the Romans leveled Jerusalem & its Temple in AD 70.)
 - b. In Matthew 23:37-39, Jesus continued: "Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who murdered the prophets and stoned those who were sent to you, how often I wanted to gather your children together as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing!

 Behold! Your house is left to you desolate. For I tell you, you will never see Me again until you say, 'Blessed is He who comes in the Name of the Lord.'"
 - c. In the latter passage, Jesus "divorces" the Jews as a <u>nation</u>. As a <u>nation</u> they had served their purpose; through them the <u>genealogy</u> of Jesus had been preserved. But now Jesus—by Himself—would generate a "New Israel" (namely, the Holy Christian Church), not generate a <u>resurgence</u> of the present <u>Jewish nation</u> or the "Old Israel"!
- 9. Christians should not take SPIRITUAL sides; however, they can take political sides!
 WHY?
 - a. *Israel* is a "parliamentary democracy"!
 - **b.** *Islam* (ex. Hamas) is a Christian threat (remember America's "**9-11**")

PART B

TO THE HEART AND CORE OF THE PROBLEM

Christians need to understand **Romans 9—11**, especially the *pertinent* verses of **Romans 11:25-27**. The apostle Paul writes:

To keep you from thinking too highly of yourselves, my fellow Christians, I want you to know this mystery: The minds of a part of the Jews were closed until the full number of the Gentiles comes in.

26 And in this way all srae will be saved, as it is written: The Savior will come from Zion; He will get rid of ungodliness in Jacob.

27 And this will be My "last will and testament" with them when I take away their sins.

Three [3] views of Romans 11:26a are given by Armin J. Panning in his NPH commentary on Romans (p. 193). View 1: Premillennialism, is rejected by true Amillennial Lutherans. See Article XVII of the Augsburg Confession where conservative-confessing Lutherans denounce "certain Jewish opinions which are even now making an appearance and which teach that, before the resurrection of the dead, saints and godly men will possess a worldly kingdom and annihilate all the godless."

Premillennialism is rejected by **Jesus** when He said to Pontus Pilate, "**My** Kingdom is <u>not</u> of this world." (Some Lutherans accept a *limited* form of Premillennialism, and thereby reject the more *drastic* form of Premillennialism, namely, Dispensationalism, as endorsed by Dallas Theological Seminary and Moody Bible Institute. This, however, does not excuse so-called Lutherans [LINO's] from going against the *Lutheran Confessions*, teaching that **Jesus** will rule <u>on earth</u> for **1,000** years <u>prior</u> to Judgment day.)

We now cite Panning's listing of the three [3] prominent views of **Romans 11:26**, in particular the phrase, "<u>all</u> Israel will be saved!" (Views 2 & 3 are seen by true Lutherans as *viable* possibilities; View 1 is <u>not!</u>)

- **a. View 1:** "All Israel" refers to the *nation* descended from Abraham (hence <u>all</u> people of Jewish extraction will eventually be saved).
- **b. View 2:** "All Israel" refers to the Christian Church, the sum total of <u>all</u> God's elect, both *Jews* and *Gentiles*.
- **C. View 3:** "All Israel" refers to **GOD**'s elect from among the *Jewish nation*, with <u>all</u> of this *Jewish* remnant being saved.

Why is this so difficult to understand? Because it is in the wheelhouse of a GOD-mystery!!! (View 1, which implies "partiality" on GOD's part, is an impossibility on the basis of Romans 2:11: "for GOD does not favor one person over another." Think: If GOD were to save all Jews, and not all Gentiles, this would be showing "partiality"!!!)

ABOUT THE BOOK OF REVELATION—AND ITS OUTLINE

1. Revelation 1:1: Literal OR Symbolic/Figurative?

This is the revelation [unveiling] of **JESUS CHRIST** which **GOD** gave Him to show His servants the things that must happen without delay; and which He made known by visual signs when He sent it through His angel to His servant John. (Literal translation!)

This is the revelation [unveiling] of **JESUS CHRIST** which **GOD** gave Him to show His servants the things that must happen without delay; and He sent this revelation by way of symbols through His angel to His servant John. (Semi-paraphrastic translation!)

2. The 7-fold outline of the book of Revelation—in repeat mode:

A. Introduction (1:1-20)

First vision: Seven letters (2:1—3:22)
 Second vision: Seven seals (4:1—7:17)

3. Third vision: Seven trumpets (8:1—11:19)

4. Fourth vision: The woman and the dragon (12:1—15:4)

5. Fifth vision: Seven bowls (15:5—16:21)

6. Sixth vision: God's final triumph (17:1—20:15) **7. Seventh vision:** God's new world (21:1—22:5)

B. Conclusion (22:6-21)

3. Revelation 1:1—22:21: Chronological OR Repetitious? A 3-fold example—
a. Revelation 12:7 ("dragon"); 13:1a ("beast from the sea"); & 13:11a ("beast from the earth"! In 19:19, 20, one should note both the "beast from the sea" and the "beast from the earth" are paired up. (The latter is now called the "false prophet"!)

12:7: And then a war broke out in heaven—Michael and his angels had to fight with the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels;

13:1a: And I saw a *beast* coming up <u>out of the sea</u>—

13:11a: And I saw another beast come up out of the earth;

19:19, 20: And I saw the beast ["the beast out of the sea," cf. 13:1ff.] and the kings of the earth and their armies gathered to fight against the Rider on the horse and His army. And the beast was captured and with him the false prophet ["the beast out of the earth" (cf. 13:11)], who had worked miraculous signs for the beast [the one "out of the sea"] by which he [the false prophet] deceived those who had received the brand of the beast and worshiped his image; both were thrown alive into the fiery lake of burning sulfur.

b. Revelation 9:13-16

And the <u>sixth</u> angel blew his trumpet. And I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar before God. 14 It said to the <u>sixth</u> angel (he was the one who had the trumpet): "Free the four angels who are held bound at the great river <u>Euphrates</u>."

15 And the four angels who had been held ready for that hour and day and month and year were untied to kill a third of the people. 16 And the number of soldiers on horses was 200,000,000; I heard how many there were.

c. Revelation 16:12-14

- 12 And the <u>sixth</u> poured out his bowl on the great river <u>Euphrates</u>. And the water in it dried up to prepare the road for the kings from the east. 13 And I saw three unclean spirits, like frogs, come out of the mouth of the *dragon* and out of the mouth of the *beast* and out of the mouth of the *false prophet* [the "beast out of the earth"]. 14 For they are spirits of **demons**, working miraculous signs, who go out to the kings of the whole world to gather them for the war [*Armageddon*] on the great Day/Judgment Day of the Almighty GOD.
- d. And what about the "millennial" interpretation of Revelation 4:1?
 1 After these things I [John the apostle] looked, and there a door open in heaven, and I heard the first voice like a trumpet speaking to me. It said: "Come up here, and I will show you what must happen after these things." The "rapture"? NOT!

PARTS A & B—A Summary of & Addition to:

SUMMARY

Leverything concerning the past (from the AD 600s) & present Palestinian & Israeli conflicts is about the "blessing/curse" motif laid out in Genesis 12:3a, b. The Muslim faction, as well as the Jewish faction, have rejected Jesus as Savior and His plan of redemption. Thus, both groups have come under the curse of the Almighty GOD, because both groups denounce the doctrine of the HOLY TRINITY and HIS spelled-out way of salvation, namely, trust in Jesus for the forgiveness of human transgressions.

Since the Jews rejected Jesus when He was on earth, Matthew 23 tells us that Jesus divorced the Jews as a nation, putting them under GOD's curse and taking the land of Canaan away from them. After that, Jesus gave the land of the whole world to Christians and told them to evangelize it before they die and inherit the land of heaven.

As for Muslims, they also fall under GOD's curse since they also have rejected the true genealogical line of Abraham which ran through Isaac down to Jesus. Instead, they have chosen to follow the non-messianic line of Abraham which ran through Abraham's non-chosen son, Ishmael (see Galatians 4:21-23).

During our last session, we also concluded that Paul's statement in **Romans 9:26**, namely, "<u>all</u> Israel shall be saved," <u>cannot</u> mean that <u>at the end of time</u> every living *Jew* will come to <u>faith</u>—and be taken to heaven. That would be showing <u>favoritism</u> on <u>GOD</u>'s part if He did not also take every *Gentile* to heaven. **Romans 2:11** teaches that God does <u>not</u> show "partiality"! (Of course, this conclusion is rejected by the *majority* of evangelicals who, for the most part, are of a Premillennialist or Dispensational persuasion.)

ADDITIONS—WITH SOME REPEAT TO LET "TRUTH" SINK IN

Great confusion often fills the minds of Lutherans (both pastors and laypersons) who listen to media personalities like David Jeremiah, Hal Lindsey, Chuck Missler, John Hagee, etc. They all preach "Christ and Him crucified," assumedly are saved Christians, and are very dynamic and persuasive preachers. However, they are not to be trusted when they treat the *apocalyptic* sections of books like *Isaiah* and *Ezekiel*—and this especially includes the book of *Revelation*. These heralds of the "secret rapture," advocating two [2] Comings of Jesus prior to His Final Coming, well, they throw many biblical teachings out of kilter, contrary to our Lutheran Confessions.

A sample of just one wild interpretation: Hal Lindsey/Chuck Missler and the "locusts" of Revelation 9:7a: "locusts looked like horses prepared for battle." Both men say the "locusts" are a prediction of "helicopters" that will fight against Christians in the last days. (NOTE: They switch from *literal* to *symbolic* at will.)

2. Remember the words of Article XVII of the Augsburg Confession where conservative-confessing Lutherans denounce "certain Jewish opinions which are even now making an appearance and which teach that, before the resurrection of the dead, saints and godly men will possess a worldly kingdom and annihilate all the godless."

Also recall that the idea of "premillennialism" is rejected by Jesus when He said to Pontus Pilate, "My Kingdom is not of this world." Christ will not be reigning on earth for a thousand [1,000] years] BEFORE Judgment Day.

Those Lutherans, who endorse "millennialism," are <u>not</u> true *Amillennial* Lutherans. *Amillennial* Lutherans do <u>not</u> believe that **Revelation 20** teaches a "*literal*" **1,000** year reign **BEFORE** Satan is "loosed" for a "short period of time". (We shall deal with **Revelation 20** next time in **PART C** of our study—for the whole session.)

As stated last week, these *deceived* Lutherans can be called **LINO's**, "Lutherans-In-Name-Only"! They definitely side with Israel against the Palestinians, feeling that **GOD** sides with Israel—**politically**. They do <u>not</u> have a clue that **GOD** looks at the Palestinian-Israeli conflict *SPIRITUALLY*. They also tend to rip **Psalm 122:6** where it says, "Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee"--KJV) out of its OT context and

away from its *SPIRITUA*L meaning. Once again, this is right in line with *secular* American politics which fears that GOD's curse will fall on any *nation* that does <u>not</u> side with Israel. Of course, this is a total misinterpretation of **Genesis 12:3**, as we have taught. Those who do <u>not</u> have **sharp** *SPIRITUAL* eyes will only see things from a **political** viewpoint. So sad and dishonoring to our GOD!!!

PART C

THE "REVELATION 20" DEBATE

- 1. Two [2] basic views of the number 1,000 years in Revelation 20:
 - a. The "*literal*" view
 - **b.** The "*symbolic/figurative*" view
- 2. The Lutheran interpretation of Revelation 20:1-15:

THE DEVIL'S LAST BATTLE

Satan bound / 1 And I saw an Angel coming down from heaven, holding the key to the bottomless pit and a large chain in His hand;

2 and <mark>He</mark> overpowered the dragon—

he is the *old serpent*, which is **Devil** and **Satan**—

and **He** bound him for a **thousand** years,

3 and threw him into the bottomless pit,

and shut it

and sealed it over him to keep him from deceiving the Gentiles anymore until the thousand years would end;

after these things he must be set free for a little while.

Christians /

4 And I saw thrones,

and they sat on them and to them was given authority to judge;

and I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded,

because of their testimony of Jesus

and because of the word of God.

And they had <u>not</u> worshiped the beast nor his image

and were not branded on their foreheads and on their hands;

and they lived and ruled with Christ for a thousand years.

5 The **rest of the dead** did not live <u>until</u> the **thousand** years came to an end.

This is the first resurrection.

("Rest of the dead" refers to those <u>not</u> converted <u>during</u> the **1,000** years. However, those who are converted to **CHRISTianity** become part of the **First Resurrection**, that is, they became **SPIRITUALLY** alive **BEFORE** they died physically (see **Ephesians 2:1-5**).

6 Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection.

The second death has no power over them.

But they will continue to be priests of God and of Christ.

And they will rule with Him for a thousand years.

Satan freed; then eternally destroyed

THE JUDGMENT

- 7 And whenever the thousand years come to an end,
 - *Satan* will be freed from his prison.
 - And he will go out to deceive the Gentiles in all parts of the world—
 that is, Gog and Magog—to gather them for battle;
 they will be as many as the sand by the sea.
 - 9 And they came up, spreading over the broad expanse of the earth, and surrounded the camp of the believers and the city He loves.

 And fire came down from heaven and consumed them.
- 10 And the **devil** who <u>deceived</u> them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur, where the **beast** and the **false prophet** are, and they will be tortured day and night <u>forever and ever</u> [12 times in **Revelation**].

Judgment Day

- 11 And I saw a great White Throne and the ONE sitting on it from whose presence the earth and the sky fled away, and no place was found for them.
- 12 And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne.

 And books were opened,

and another book was opened—the **Book of Life**.

And the dead were judged on the basis of the things written in the books according to what they had done.

- And the sea gave up the dead who were in it, and death and hades gave up the dead who were in them, and each one was judged according to what he had done.
- 14 And *death and hades* were thrown into the fiery lake. The fiery lake is the second death.
- 15 And if anyone was <u>not</u> found written in the **Book of Life**, he was thrown into the fiery lake.

THE FUTURE:

An Amillennial Perspective

—A Biblical Study of Things to Come—

"We have now arrived at Revelation 20, the so-called <u>keystone of prophecy</u>. This single passage is so important to <u>premillennialists</u> that they are willing to retrace their steps back through the <u>entire</u> Bible and <u>reinterpret</u> it in the light of what they think this passage teaches. All Scripture concerning <u>Israel</u>, <u>the resurrection</u>, <u>the judgment</u>, etc. must now be reevaluated in the light of this passage. This seems wrong, but before proceeding with the error of this thought and the interpretation of **Revelation 20**, it is necessary to first think of *Revelation* as a whole (p. 121).

...

"Note that according to this view, the book of *Revelation* has seven sections which run somewhat parallel to each other. Each section, <u>under a different symbol</u>, depicts good **and** evil (church **and** world) *from the first advent of Christ to the time of His Second Coming*. **This, of course, differs greatly from the concept that what happens in one chapter <u>always</u> follows that which happened in the preceding chapter**" (p. 122). (The seven [7] sections/visions of *Revelation* are **not chronological**, [as Sanders pointed out], even though *millennialists* strongly disagree.)

...

Now Sanders goes on to state seven [7] features of Revelation (pp. 122-125):

- 1. "Revelation is apocalyptic literature."
- 2. "The symbols of *Revelation* cannot be interpreted *literally*."
- **3.** "Biblical books written in *figurative* language should be interpreted *figuratively* unless there are indications to do otherwise."
- **4.** "Obscure passages of Scripture must be interpreted by the <u>clear</u> and <u>plain</u> passages, not vice versa." (Interpretive principle: "Scripture Interprets Scripture" or "Scripture Interprets Itself." To the contrary, millennialists use the difficult book of *Revelation* to interpret sections of the Bible that are much clearer.)
- 5. "Persecution of Christians was severe when Revelation was written."
- **6.** "The purpose of *Revelation* was to reveal *through symbols* the conflict between good and evil and the *results* of that conflict."

- 7. "The theme of *Revelation* is <u>Christian victory</u>." **Giessler:** "Four [4] words summarize the book of *Revelation*, namely, 'Jesus wins; we win'"! Sanders divides the 20th chapter of *Revelation* into four [4] sections (pp. 125-139):
 - a. 20:1-3 The Binding of Satan on Earth
 - **b.** 20:4-6 The Reigning of Martyrs in Heaven*
 - c. 20:7-10 First the Loosing then the Ultimate Overthrow of Satan
 - **d.** 20:11-15 The Judgment
- *"Some amillennialists, including Augustine, do not limit Revelation 20:4-6 to a heavenly scene. These generally believe the reigning with Christ begins when one is regenerated [converted] here on earth. It, therefore, is believed to include the regenerated who have not died as well as those who have passed from physical life" (p. 135).
- (ADDITION: The following NT passages seem to support Augustine's position that Christians still on earth are already thought of as being in the "heavenlies"—KJV:
- a. Ephesians 2:6 "HE also <u>raised</u> us up with Him and <u>seated</u> us with Him <u>in the heavens</u> with Christ Jesus,...."—CSB.
- b. Ephesians 4:8c "You have become kings...."—NET.
- c. Revelation 5:10 "and You made them a kingdom and priests to our GOD and they will continue to rule as kings on the earth"—NET.
- d. 1 Peter 2:9 "but you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for GOD's own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of HIM who has called you out of darkness into HIS marvelous light"—NAS.)

Sander's conclusion for Revelation 20 (p. 140): "How shall we conclude our study of Revelation 20? The *premillennial* interpretation makes Revelation 20 contradict both itself and the Bible as a whole. Their interpretation, rather than being a key to the understanding of prophecy, actually locks out any true prophetic understanding. It has been shown that the one passage that is supposed to fully support the *premillennial* view actually is silent about all its *major* tenants such as Jews, Palestine, Temple, sacrifices, increased productivity, longevity, etc.


"On the other hand, it has been shown that a more *symbolic* interpretation harmonizes with the rest of the Bible, the language and purpose of *Revelation* as a whole, and chapter 20 in particular. Once the *symbolism* is understood, there is no necessity to *reinterpret* the whole Bible. The one chapter which is said to clearly teach an exact one-thousand-year earthly and visible reign of Christ simply does not do so. If premillennialism cannot succeed in Revelation 20, it cannot Scripturally prevail anywhere."


TIME CHARTS

Composed of Seven [7] Sub-Visions

The Woman & The Dragon

12TH CHAPTER

THE FIRST SUB-VISION: THE GREAT FIRE-RED DRAGON-12:1-18

The Woman's Son and the Dragon (12:1-6)

- And a great miraculous sign was seen in heavena woman with the sun for her garment and the moon under her feet and a crown of twelve stars on her head;
- 2 and she was pregnant, and she cried out in pain and agony to give birth.
- 3 And another miraculous sign was seen in heaven and look, a large fire-red dragon with seven heads and ten horns and with seven crowns on his heads;
- 4 and his tail swept away a third of the stars in heaven and hurled them to the earth; and the dragon stood in front of the woman who was going to have a Child to devour her Child whenever it was born.
- 5 And she gave birth to a Son, a Boy,

who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron.

And her Child was taken straight up to God and to His throne.

6 And the woman fled into the wilderness

where God has prepared a place for her so that she might be fed for 1,260 days.*

*"1,260 days" and "42 months" (**Revelation 13:5**) and "a time, and times, and half a time" (**Daniel 7:25**) are terms that specify the same amount of time.

The War in Heaven (12:7-12)

- 7 And then a war broke out in heaven— Michael and his angels had to fight with the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels;
- 8 but he was not strong enough nor was there a place for them in heaven any longer;
- 9 and the great dragon was hurled down the old serpent, called Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world, was hurled to the earth; and his angels were hurled down with him.
- **10** And I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying:

"Now has come the salvation and the power and the Kingdom of our God and the rule of His Christ,

because the accuser of our fellow Christians, the one accusing them before our God-day and nighthas been thrown out;

- and they conquered him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony; and they did not love their life but were willing to die.
- For this be glad, you heavens, and those who live in them.

 Woe to the earth and the sea,

 because the devil has come down to you with great anger,

 knowing that he has little time." (Compare Revelation 20:3e—"short season"!)

Requoting Sanders (p. 10 of our present outline): "Note that *Revelation* has seven sections/_visions_ which run *somewhat* parallel to each other (cp. **Revelation 12:10-12a** with **20:11-15**; **13:16h**, i with **20:4h**) Each section, <u>under a different *symbol*</u>, depicts good and evil (church and world) from the first advent of Christ to the time of His Second Coming. This, of course, differs greatly from the _millennial_ concept that what happens in one chapter <u>always</u> follows that which happened in the preceding chapter" (p. 122).

The Dragon Persecutes the Woman (12:13-18)

- **13** And when the dragon saw that he had been hurled to the earth, he persecuted the woman who had given birth to the Boy.
- 14 And the woman was given two wings of the great eagle to fly to her place in the wilderness away from the serpent, where she would be fed for a time and times and half a time.
- **15** And from his mouth the serpent poured out a stream of water after the woman in order to sweep her away like a river.
- **16** And the earth helped the woman.

And the earth opened its mouth

and swallowed the stream that the dragon poured from his mouth.

- 17 And the dragon was angry with the woman and went away to fight with her other children, those who keep what God has commanded and who hold on to the testimony of Jesus.
- **18** And he stood on the sandy shore of the sea.

13_{TH CHAPTER}

THE <u>SECOND</u> SUB-VISION: THE <u>BEAST</u> <u>FROM THE SEA</u>—<u>13:1-10*</u>

- And I saw a beast coming up out of the sea he had ten horns and seven heads, and on his horns ten crowns ** and there were blasphemous names on his heads;
- * Quensted, a great Lutheran commentator who lived nearly a century after Luther, spoke of an Eastern [political] Antichrist AS WELL AS a Western [religious "within the church" Antichrist]. The Eastern Antichrist (Revelation 13:1-12) represents all governmental/secular powers opposed to Christ. In its final revealing, it seems to indicate Islam, more of a political entity than a religious one. This is shown by Muslim domination once its Sharia [Sharia Law] is set into action via its members coming into the majority in a certain location.

The Western Antichrist according to 2 Thessalonians 2:4 "sits in GOD's temple"! In the "Smalcald Articles" of the Lutheran Confessions, Luther identifies this second Beast that comes out of the earth. He writes, "the pope is himself the true Antichrist." We shall speak to this point in our study of 2 Thessalonians 2 at the end of our study of the 2023 PALESTINIAN & ISRAELI CONFLICT. In advance, we remind you that Beast 2 is also called the "False Prophet" in the book of Revelation. This agrees with calling the Western Antichrist the "religious" Antichrist. This footnote also applies to the "THIRD SUB-VISION" at Revelation 13:11.

and the beast which I saw was like a leopard and his feet were like those of a bear and his mouth like a lion's mouth;* and the dragon gave him his power and his throne and great authority.**

3 And one of his heads seemed to have been fatally wounded, but his fatal wound was healed.

And the whole world was amazed and followed after the beast

4 and worshiped the dragon because he had given authority to the beast; and they worshiped the beast, saying:

"Is there anyone like the beast?

And is there anyone who can fight with him?"

- **5** And he was given a mouth speaking proud and blasphemous things, and he was given authority to act for <u>42 months</u>.
- **6** And he opened his mouth to blaspheme God, to blaspheme His Name and His TABERNACLE, those who are living [tabernacling] in heaven.
- 7 And he was given [authority]
 to wage war against the believers
 and to conquer them,
 and he was given authority

over every tribe and people and language and nation.

8 And everyone living on the earth will worship him,

[everyone] whose name is not written in the Book of Life,

[that Book] which belongs to the Lamb

who was slain from the beginning of the world.

- **9** If anyone has an ear, let him listen:
- *Compare the "beasts" of Daniel 7. Calculate those four [4] beasts mentioned there and remember that together they have seven [7] heads. Also recall that the "Fourth Beast" of Daniel 7 had ten [10] horns. John does not mention Daniel's "Fourth Beast" but does mention the "10" horns. Thus, we can make symbolical sense of John's description when he speaks of the Beast out of the sea as having 10 horns and 7 heads. (Taken from B,TDTS, p. 195.)
 - Recall **Revelation 13:1** above: "And I saw a beast coming up out of the sea—he had ten horns and seven heads, and on his horns ten crowns." This is another reminder that *Revelation* is made up of many, many words and terms and quotes from the Old Testament.

10 If anyone is to be taken prisoner,

to prison he will go.

If anyone is to be killed with a sword,

with a sword he must be killed.

In this situation the believers need patient endurance and confidence.

THE THIRD SUB-VISION: THE BEAST FROM THE EARTH—13:11-18

11 And I saw another beast come up out of the earth; and he had two horns like the Lamb [being "Lamblike"], but he talked like the dragon.

12 And he exercises all the authority of the first beast before him.

And he makes the earth

and those living on it

worship the first beast,

whose fatal wound was healed.

13 And he works great miraculous signs

so that he even makes fire come down

from heaven to the earth

in front of the people.

14 And he deceives those living on the earth

because of the miraculous signs that he is given to do in front of the beast,

telling those living on the earth to make an image

for the beast who was wounded by a sword and yet lived.

15 And he was given power to put breath into the image of the beast

so that the image of the beast could both talk and cause

as many as would not worship the image of the beast to be put to death.

16 And he forces all people,

great

and small

and rich

and poor

and free

and slave

to be branded on their right hands

or on their foreheads,

and Lhe does it so that no one may buy

or sell.

unless one has the brand—the beast's name

or the number of his name. Recall **Revelation 20:4 f, g**—now a *symbolic* repeat!

* For a little humor, quote CN, Nov. 20, 2023, p. 6.

18 In this situation wisdom is needed. Let the person who has insight calculate* the number of the beast, because it is a human number; and his number is 666.** Calculate" is the same Greek word used by Jesus when He spoke of the man who "calculated" the cost of a tower he intended to build (Luke 14:28). **The book of *Revelation* was written in Greek. The Greek word **LATEINOS** means "the Latin-man"! Irenaeus conjectured that adding the Greek numerals of LATEINOS together might be "a very likely solution" to the meaning of John's 666.! Becker(B,RDTS, p. 213) notes the value of each Greek letter: L= 30; T= 300; 5: I= 10; N = 50;O= 70; S= 200, which added together equals 666! Such calculation is called GEMATRIA and, if true, it would be the only use of this phenomenon in Scripture. However, Revelation 13:18 says that the reader with "insight" should "calculate" the 666 to determine its meaning. Thus, "the Latin-man" solution seems the most fitting in light of 2 Thessalonians 2, which we shall interpret below. Also, Becker (p. 215) insightfully points out that 666 has three numerals that three times falls short of 777, "7" being the number of perfection, which is quite definitive of GOD who is "Holy, Holy, Holy" in Isaiah 6:3b. Thus, 666 would represent the "UNHOLY TRINITY"—the "Dragon, Beast 1, and Beast 2 [the False Prophet], always falling short of being equal to GOD, even though Satan often tries to mimic his superior **CREATOR**. Intriguing!!!

2. Exegesis of 2 Thessalonians 2:1-17

2_{ND} CHAPTER

"The "Man of Sin"

1 Our Lord Jesus Christ is coming, and we will be gathered to meet Him. But we ask you, fellow Christians, 2 not to lose your heads quickly or become alarmed either by a "spirit" message or by a word or by a letter that *supposedly* comes from us, saying, "The Day of the Lord has <u>already</u> come!" 3 Do not let anyone *deceive* you in any way. For the revolt must *first* take place, and the "man of sin" who is doomed to destruction must be revealed. 4 He opposes and sets himself above everyone who is GOD's representative or to whom honor is due, so that he sits in GOD's temple and proclaims that he is GOD.

5 Do you not remember that told you this when was still with you? 6 And now you know what is holding him back, so that he will be revealed when his time comes. 7 For this "rebellious thing" is already working secretly, but only until He who is now holding it back gets out of the way. 8 Then the "rebellious one" will be revealed, and the Lord Jesus will destroy him with the breath of His mouth and make him powerless at His return appearance.

9 The coming of this "rebellious one" is the work of Satan, who uses all types of misleading miracles, miraculous signs, and wonderful proofs 10 and every kind of wrongdoing which deceives those who are perishing, because they refused to love the truth and so be saved. 11 That is why GOD sends a deception which works effectively, so that they might believe the lie [because the Papacy appears to be "Lamblike"!] 12 and all might be condemned who did not believe the truth but delighted in wrongdoing.

God Has Chosen You!

13 But we have a *continuing* obligation to thank GOD for you, fellow Christians, whom the Lord loves, because in the beginning GOD chose you to be made holy by the SPIRIT, to believe the truth, and so to be saved. 14 For this purpose also He called you by the Gospel which we preach; He wants you to have the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

15 Stand then, fellow Christians, and cling to the instructions we handed down to you when we spoke to you or wrote to you.

16 Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who loved us and by His grace gave us everlasting comfort and good hope, 17 comfort you inwardly and strengthen you to do and say everything that is good.*

*Luther primarily saw the Papacy as the Antichrist since it denounced the doctrine of "justification by faith alone" during Session VI, Canon 12 of the Council of Trent.

Thus, we end our 4-PART Readers' Digest presentation of "What Is a Christian to Think" in terms of THE PRESENT 2023 PALESTINIAN AND ISRAELI CONFLICT.

Our Conclusions:

- **a.** All biblical endorsements of *any* conflicts must be decided *SPIRITUALLY* on the basis of Scripture's "blessing/curse" motif, as spelled out in Genesis 12:3!
- **b.** Muslim rejection of the **TRINITY** and Jewish rejection of **Jesus** as **Messiah** and **Savior** of the world places both groups under the "curses" of **GOD**.
- c. The world's conclusions as to choosing sides in any nation-faces-nation conflict finds decisions being made on the basis of political, not SPIRITUAL factors.
 GOD does not think like worldly politicians!!!
- d. As to the Jews, GOD chose them to establish a genealogical line down to the birth of the Messiah. However, when the Jewish people rejected Jesus as Savior from sin, He "divorced" them as a nation when in Matthew 23 He said, "I leave to you your house desolate." This final divorce action was carried out in AD 70 when the city of Jerusalem and its Temple were destroyed, even leveled and some 1,100,000 Jews were massacred and many others were made slaves.
- e. The non-biblical view of millennialists, both Premillennialists & Dispensationalists, makes a mockery of Scriptural truth. The view that Christ will come back 1,007 years BEFORE Judgment Day and physically remove all Christians from earth via a "secret rapture" before the "Great Tribulation"! Then seven ["7"] years later, it is said that Jesus will resurrect all the Jesus and deliver them from the Antichrist. At the same time, Jesus will bring back all the Christians who were formerly raptured. He will then set up an earthly Kingdom for 1,000 literal years and reign on earth from Jerusalem prior to Judgment Day.
 - We have shown that **Revelation 20** does not teach any of this!!! In fact, **Christ** taught that **He** would <u>not ever</u> have an *earthly* Kingdom when **He** said to Pontus Pilate: "**My** Kingdom is <u>not</u> of this world."
- **f.** At long length, we studied the book of *Revelation*, showing FOUR other crucial things:
 - 1) Revelation is <u>not</u> chronological; rather, seven ["7"] times it repeats itself, via seven visions, the data previously given, providing enhanced information.
 - **2)** Revelation is apocalyptical/revelatory literature that speaks **symbolically**, that is, it communicates **figuratively**, in **symbols**, <u>not</u> primarily in a **literal** way. (We showed that **Revelation 20** is mangled when taken in a **literal** way.)

- **3.** The *symbolic*/difficult passages of *Revelation* should not be used to interpret other Scriptural texts that are much more clear. As Sanders stated, "Obscure passages of Scripture must be interpreted by the <u>clear</u> and <u>plain</u> passages, not vice versa."
- **4.** Earthly *conflicts* are the work of Satan & the Eastern & Western Antichrists (Revelation 12 & 13).
- **h.** The terms "Last Days" & "Last Times" refers to the entire N period from Christ's First Coming to His Second Coming.
- i. The "signs" that Jesus spelled out in Matthew 24, signs that reoccur time-after-time until He returns, can be helpful as one evaluates THE PRESENT 2023 PALESTINIAN & ISRAELI CONFLICT:
 - 1) Lawlessness/persecution
 - 2) Apostasy/"falling away"-Matthew 24:10
 - **3)** Turmoil in the world–bombings, beheadings, etc.
 - 4) Upheavals in nature—earthquakes, etc.
 - 5) Gospel-spreading (example: Africa; Europe; conversion of Muslims)
 - **6)** Good verses bad: **LGBTQIA** intrusion finding Presbyterian & Methodist congregations leaving their former church bodies
 - 7) "Foolishness" (ex.: "spend your way out of debt") (Romans 1:20c-22)
