WHY SHOULD YOU ATTEND?

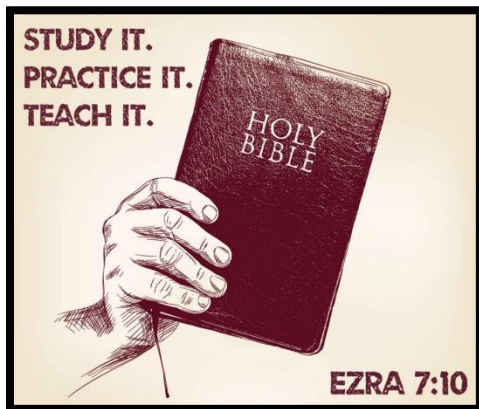
Having been made alive in Christ, *we need spiritual nourishment!* That should take place at home each day, but also each week in Divine Service and Bible Class / SS.

PARENTS ARE IMPORTANT

Children are gifts from God to parents! They need both physical and spiritual nourishment; consider the following:

- Jesus said that “**Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God**” (Matthew 4:4 NAS). *So bread for the body, the Bible for the soul!*
- It’s the parents’ responsibility to impress the Word of God upon their children – for their GREAT benefit!

The LORD said through Moses to the parents: ^{NIV} **Deuteronomy 6:6-9** “These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.”

- In the passage above, **FIRST** God’s Word is to be upon our hearts as parents; **THEN** we will be equipped to impress it upon our children.
