Worship at Bethlehem:

Our worship is traditional and Christ-centered, shaped by Scripture and the historic Lutheran liturgy.

- We gather around God's Word and Sacraments.
- Worship includes hymns, readings from the Bible, prayers, a sermon, and the Lord's Supper.
- The service follows a printed bulletin—you don't need to know anything ahead of time.
- You are free to participate as much or as little as you're comfortable.

If you've never experienced a liturgical service before, don't worry—many visitors find it reverent, peaceful, and grounding.
