↑ CONFESSION and ABSOLUTION:

- L: In the name of the Father and of the † Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: **Amen.**
- L: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- C: **But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**

Silence for reflection on God's Word and for self-examination.

L: [kneel / stand] Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

A: Most merciful God, I confess that I am by nature sinful and unclean.

⇒ **I have sinned against You in *thought, word, and deed, by what I have done and by what I have left undone.***

⇒ **I have *not* loved You with my whole heart; I have *not* loved my neighbors as myself.**

⇒ **I justly deserve Your *present and eternal punishment.***

For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on me. Forgive me, renew me, and lead me, so that I may *delight* in Your will and *walk* in Your ways to the *glory* of Your holy name. Amen.

L: In the mercy of almighty God, Jesus Christ was given to die for us, and for His sake God forgives us all our sins. To those who believe in Jesus Christ He gives the power to become the children of God and bestows on them the Holy Spirit. May the Lord, who has begun this good work in us, bring it to completion in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ!

C: Amen.

I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed" (ESV).

He would be born of a virgin:

Isaiah 7:14: ...the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel (ESV).

Isaiah 9:6-7: For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this (ESV).

Micah 5:2: But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days (ESV).

What Child Is This?

He is the Saving One!

He came to save His people from their sins:

Matthew 1:18-21: Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly. But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, “Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins” (ESV).

He came to redeem us:

Galatians 4:4-5: But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons (ESV).

What Child Is This? *He is the Transforming One!*

He came to make us new:

2 Corinthians 5:17-18, 21: Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself... For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God (ESV).

John 1:11-13: He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him. But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God (ESV).

Matthew 5:14-16: [Jesus said to His followers:] "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand,

and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven" (ESV).

ATHANASIAN CREED – Part of the Creed:

- L: He is God, begotten from the substance of the Father, before all ages; and He is man, born from the substance of His mother in this age:
- C: **perfect God and perfect man, composed of a rational soul and human flesh;**
- L: Equal to the Father with respect to His divinity, less than the Father with respect to His humanity.
- C: **Although He is God and man, He is not two, but one Christ:**
- L: one, however, not by the conversion of the divinity into flesh, but by the assumption of the humanity into God;
- C: **one altogether, not by confusion of substance, but by unity of person.**
- L: For as the rational soul and flesh is one man, so God and man is one Christ,
- C: **Who suffered for our salvation, descended into hell, rose again the third day from the dead,**

L: ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father, God Almighty, from whence He will come to judge the living and the dead.
