## 1 God, 3 Persons

## For Our Salvation!!!

The Holy Trinity – 2018

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: On this Sunday of the Holy Trinity, we believe, teach, and confess that there is 1 God, and yet, at the same time, that 1 God includes 3 Persons: <u>the Person of the Father</u>, <u>the Person of the Son</u>, and <u>the Person of the Holy Spirit</u>! As those three Persons worked together to create all things, so they also <u>work</u> <u>together for our salvation</u>!!!

Today, as we focus on the middle part of Acts chapter 2, let us \*see and \*marvel at the individual work, as well as the collective work, of the **Holy Trinity** to save us from our sins!

- Miracles, Crucifixion, Resurrection: <sup>14</sup> But Peter, standing with the eleven [the eleven other apostles, on the Day of Pentecost, which was 50 days after Easter], lifted up his voice and addressed them: <sup>22</sup> "Men of Israel, hear these words: // As Peter spoke God's Word, <u>the Holy Spirit was</u> <u>at work through that Word</u>!
  - a. <u>Miracles</u>: Jesus of Nazareth [the Son of God], a man attested to you by God [the Father] with mighty works and wonders and signs that God [the Father] did through <u>him</u> [His Son] in your midst, as you yourselves know— // Peter established the connection between God the Father and Jesus by referencing the miracles!

- b. <u>Crucifixion</u>: <sup>23</sup> this Jesus [God the Son in human flesh], delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of <u>God</u> [the Father], you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men. // As Peter spoke to Jews, he reminded them of what they had done 53 days earlier on Good Friday – as they handed Jesus over to Pilate to crucify Him – but he also declared that it happened <u>because God the Father had planned it out</u>!
- c. <u>Resurrection</u>: <sup>24</sup> <u>God</u> [the Father] raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for <u>him</u> [the Son of God] to be held by it. // Keep in mind, the Jewish leaders thought Jesus was teaching and acting in opposition to God the Father; therefore, again, Peter reinforced the connection between the Father and Jesus <u>with the Father raising Him up</u>!
- Father > Spirit > David > Son: In this section the Holy Spirit moved David to write these words regarding Jesus:
  <sup>25</sup> For David says concerning <u>him</u> [the Son of God],
  - a. '<u>I</u> saw <u>the Lord</u> [God the Father] always before me, for he is at my right hand that I may not be shaken; <sup>26</sup> therefore my heart was glad, and my tongue rejoiced; my flesh also will dwell in hope. // For Jesus, <u>God the Father was with Him and blessed Him</u>!
  - b. <sup>27</sup> For you [my Father] will not abandon my soul [the soul of Your Son] to <u>Hades</u> [the place of the dead], or let your <u>Holy One</u> [Your Holy Son] see corruption. // The Holy Spirit spoke through David <u>to prophecy about Jesus'</u> <u>resurrection</u>!
  - c. <sup>28</sup> You have made known to me the paths of life; you will make me full of gladness with your presence.' //

The paths of life are repentance – *sorrow for sin*, and faith in Jesus – *for eternal life*; <u>both are accomplished</u> <u>by the Spirit working through God's Word</u>!

## 3. David, the Christ:

- a. <u>David</u>: <sup>29</sup> Brothers, I may say to you with confidence about the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. // In other words, <u>David's body did see corruption</u>.
- b. <u>The Christ</u>: <sup>30</sup> Being therefore a prophet, and knowing that <u>God</u> [the Father] had sworn with an oath to <u>him</u> [to David] that he would set one of his descendants on his throne [namely, Jesus], <sup>31</sup> he foresaw and spoke about the resurrection of <u>the Christ</u> [the Son of God, who put on flesh through the Virgin Mary and was anointed with the Holy Spirit], that...
  - i. <u>Death</u>: <u>He</u> [the Son of God] was not abandoned to Hades, nor did his flesh see corruption. // Those words pointed ahead to Jesus!
  - ii. <u>Resurrection</u>: <sup>32</sup> This Jesus <u>God</u> [the Father] raised up, and of that we all are witnesses. // So God the Father did it, thus He accepted Jesus' sacrifice for our sins! Then Peter said, "How do we know?" <u>Because we are eyewitnesses</u>!
  - iii. <u>Ascension and Pentecost</u>: <sup>33</sup> Being therefore exalted at the right hand of <u>God</u> [the Father – Jesus' ascension], and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, <u>he</u> [the Son] has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing. // We confess in the Nicene Creed that the Holy Spirit "proceeds from the

Father and the Son"; Father to Son; then Son to believers! The pouring out of the Spirit took place on the Day of Pentecost!

- <u>David</u>: <sup>34</sup> For David did not ascend into the heavens, // Instead, David died and was buried; ONLY Jesus ascended!
- <u>The Christ</u>: but <u>he</u> [David, speaking by the Holy Spirit] himself says, '<u>The Lord</u> [God the Father] said to <u>my Lord</u> [God the Son], "Sit at my right hand, <sup>35</sup> until I make your enemies your footstool."' // The Father said those words to Jesus, not to David.
- 4. Uh Oh: <sup>36</sup> Let all the house of Israel therefore know for certain that God [the Father] has made him [His Son] both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified." // When Adam and Eve fell into sin, so did all of their future descendants; therefore, God promised to send His Son!! Even though many did not and do not recognize Him or trust in Him, <u>He is BOTH LORD AND CHRIST</u>! He won salvation for everyone, but ONLY those who continue to know Him (John 17:3) will eternally benefit from His work!

**Let Us Pray**: Dear Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, You have done awesome work for our salvation; <u>Father</u> – TY for Your plan; <u>Jesus</u> – TY for living and dying; HS – TY for bringing us to the Father through Jesus and keeping us trusting in Jesus!
