

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Today's sermon, based on Mark 3:20-35, will answer these three questions:

- ⇒ Jesus was He crazy?
- Sin − can every sin be forgiven?
- **⇒** Family is it our blood and marriage relatives?

Since we are now beyond the Day of Pentecost and the Sunday of the Holy Trinity, we are now back to focusing on Jesus' ministry. What happened earlier in Mark's gospel?

- Jesus healed many people and cast out many demons!
- The people loved Jesus; the Jewish leaders hated Jesus!
- Since Jesus helped many people, multitudes \*heard the news, \*followed Him, and \*tried to touch Him!
- 1. Setting: <sup>20</sup> And [Jesus] came <a href="https://example.com/home">home</a> [to Capernaum in Galilee], and the crowd gathered again, to such an extent that [Jesus and His disciples] could not even eat a meal. // Try to imagine Jesus \*exhausted, \*hungry, and \*needing to eat, <a href="https://example.com/yET">YET</a> \*there were **SO MANY PEOPLE** and \*their needs were **SO PRESSING** that Jesus could not even eat a meal.

- 2. Jesus' Family thought Jesus had Lost It: 21 When [Jesus'] own people heard of this, they went out to take custody of Him; for they were saying, "He has lost His senses."
  - a. <u>Jesus' own people</u>: People in Jesus' hometown said, "...Is not His **mother** called Mary, and His **brothers**, James and Joseph and Simon and Judas? <sup>56</sup> And His **sisters**, are they not all with us?" (Matt. 13:55-56 NAU).
  - b. <u>Take custody</u>: That means to take control of someone. For example, a parent who has custody can make decisions for his child regarding his \*school, \*doctor, \*vaccinations, and \*religion. <u>So why did Jesus' own people seek to take control of Him</u>? Because, to them, He seemed to be OUT OF CONTROL! <u>Was that true</u>?
     No! Since He is the Son of God and had helped many people, \*many heard the news and \*sought His help!
- 3. The Scribes thought Jesus was Possessed by Satan: 22 The scribes who came down from Jerusalem were saying, "He is possessed by Beelzebul," and "He casts out the demons by the ruler of the demons."
  - a. The scribes were skilled in Jewish law and theology: When Jesus forgave the sins of a paralytic (2:6-7), the scribes said He wrongly claimed the authority of God since only God can forgive sins; then, when Jesus ate with known sinners, they wrongly criticized Him for doing so (2:16-17).
  - b. The scribes, full of evil, attempted to explain Jesus'
    exorcism success: Yes, Jesus was casting out demons,
    but how? They said Jesus was possessed by Satan, the
    ruler of the demons. Was that true? No! Jesus came
    to DEFEAT Satan©, yet the scribes said He was
    POSSESSED BY Satan©.

- 4. Jesus Responded to the Scribes: <sup>23</sup> And He called them to Himself and began speaking to them in parables,
  - a. "How can Satan cast out Satan? <sup>24</sup> If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. <sup>25</sup> If a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand. <sup>26</sup> If Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand, but he is finished! // When something is <u>united</u>, it stands; <u>divided</u>, it falls.
  - b. <sup>27</sup> But no one can enter the strong man's house [that is, Satan's house] and plunder his property unless he first binds the strong man, and then he will plunder his house." // That is exactly what Jesus did; He entered an area owned by Satan; then Jesus showed His almighty power by binding Satan and then casting out the demons who were present!
  - c. <sup>28</sup> "Truly I say to you, all sins shall be forgiven the sons of men [human beings], and whatever blasphemies they utter; <sup>29</sup> but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin"--<sup>30</sup> because they were saying, "He has an unclean spirit." // When Jesus was baptized, the Father anointed Jesus with the Holy Spirit, but the scribes said the Holy Spirit is Satan which was HORRIBLE to say!
    - i. Why is the Holy Spirit so important? The Father planned salvation and the Son did the grueling work, but ONLY the Holy Spirit can give a sinner the eternal benefits of Jesus' work (1 Corinthians 12:3)!
    - ii. What will happen to those who reject the Holy S? Jesus will say to them, "Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil and his angels" (Matt. 25:41 NAU).

## 5. Jesus Responded to His Family:

- a. <u>Biological family</u>: <sup>31</sup> Then His mother and His brothers arrived, and standing outside they sent word to Him and called Him. <sup>32</sup> A crowd was sitting around Him, and they said to Him, "Behold, Your mother and Your brothers are outside looking for You." // Jesus' flesh was from His mother, and He was also a half-brother of Mary's other children; they were His biological family.
- b. Eternal family: 33 Answering them, He said, "Who are My mother and My brothers?" 34 Looking about at those who were sitting around Him [learning from Him, trusting in Him], He said, "Behold My mother and My brothers! 35 For whoever does the will of God, he is My brother and sister and mother." // What is that will of God? Jesus said, "...everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life..." (John 6:40 NAU). That is God's PRIMARY will. But for all who keep rejecting the HS's work of repentance, all such people are condemning themselves.

## Conclusion:

- Truth Jesus: Not crazy! Sin against the HS: Unforgiveable! Family: Biological family is temporary!
- Relevance The HS is living in and blessing believers!
- Inspiration Tell the truth about Jesus, HS sin, and family!
