

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Some things in life can seem to be moving in a *particular* **unstoppable** direction, BUT THEN, **a** game changer! For example, ⇒after having had cancer, your doctor declares you to be cancer-free OR ⇒Jesus, having been entombed, is now alive forevermore! Today, as we conclude the season of Epiphany, we come to what SHOULD be a GAME CHANGER for EVERYONE!

- Setting: ²⁸ And some eight days after these sayings, it came about that He took along Peter and John and James, and went up to the mountain to pray. // <u>What sayings</u>? About a week earlier, Jesus said He would
 suffer, be rejected, and be killed, and then be raised on the third day. Since those sayings seem impossible, Luke is calling us to make a connection between <u>what</u> Jesus said and <u>what</u> happened on the mountain!
- Changes: ²⁹ And while He was praying, the appearance of His <u>face</u> became different, and His <u>clothing</u> became white and gleaming. // <u>What does Luke mean by "different"</u>?

Matthew wrote that Jesus' "face shone like the sun" (17:2). Prior to that moment, Jesus always looked like an ordinary man; then, in that moment, Jesus showed His glory! Decades later, Peter wrote, "...we were eyewitnesses of <u>His majesty</u> [His mighty power, greatness] (2 Pet. 1:16). For all who THINK Jesus is ONLY a unique man, ♦may they know the truth and ♦may that be a game changer for them!

- 3. Visitors: ³⁰ And behold, two men were talking with [Jesus]; and they were <u>Moses</u> and <u>Elijah</u>, ³¹ who, appearing <u>in glory</u> [in their heavenly form], were speaking of <u>His departure</u> [that is, His death, resurrection, and ascension] which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. // <u>Why</u> <u>Moses and Elijah</u>?
 - a. <u>Moses</u>: He is the one through whom God gave the law (*Exodus chapter 20; John 1:17; etc.*), which **we** have broken, and **Jesus** came to fulfill (Matthew 5:17)!
 - <u>Elijah</u>: He represents the prophets, which include the many prophecies about Jesus' *birth, *life, *death, *resurrection, and *ascension!
 - <u>Encouragement</u>: Moses and Elijah endured many difficult things; now, as Jesus was drawing closer to His suffering and death, Moses and Elijah encouraged Him according to His human nature.
- 4. Response: ³² Now Peter and his companions had been overcome with sleep; but when they were fully awake, they saw [Jesus'] glory and the two men standing with Him. ³³ And it came about, as these were parting from Him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good for us to be here; and <u>let us make three tabernacles</u>: one for You, and

one for Moses, and one for Elijah"-- not realizing what he was saying.

- a. <u>While they slept</u>: ⊃Jesus was transfigured, and ⊃the two men appeared. Then, when they woke up, they saw the AMAZING SITE of ♦Jesus having been
 RADICALLY CHANGED and ♦Moses and Elijah in their heavenly form!
- b. <u>And how did they know Moses and Elijah</u>? Even though they were all on a mountain on earth, *God gave Peter*, *James, and John a glimpse of heaven!* So, <u>what will</u> <u>heaven be like</u>? The Bible says, "...now we see in a mirror dimly, but then [in heaven] face to face; now I know in part, but then [in heaven] I will know fully just as I also have been fully known" (1 Cor. 13:12).
- 5. God: ³⁴ And while he was saying this, a cloud formed and began to overshadow them; and they were afraid as they entered the cloud. ³⁵ And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My Son, My Chosen One; listen to Him!" // The cloud was supernatural; it *formed quickly, *blocked their vision, and *resulted in fear. Then God the Father identified Jesus My Son, the One I have chosen to buy back the world! Then He told everyone how to respond to Jesus: "listen to Him" that is, ⇒pay attention to Him, ⇒obey Him!
- 6. Silence: ³⁶ And when the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. And they kept silent, and reported to no one in those days any of the things which they had seen. // Peter, James, and John were eyewitnesses, they *saw, *heard, and *remembered; then, beginning on the Day of Pentecost, they told EVERYTHING to EVERYONE!

- 7. Has Jesus Changed Your Game? If He has great! If not yet be open to HUGE and IMPORTANT things!
 - a. <u>Who He Is</u>: God's only begotten Son, *the Second Person* of the Trinity, who put on human flesh!
 - b. <u>What He Did</u>: Lived, suffered, died, and rose to *conquer sin, death, and the devil* and *open the way to heaven!*
 - c. <u>The benefits of Knowing Him</u>: Forgiveness of all sins, peace in every circumstance, and assurance of heaven!
 - d. <u>The consequences of Rejecting Him</u>: Worry and fear in this life; *then eternal punishment in the life to come!*

8. The Church Year Connection:

- a. During Advent, we anticipated Jesus' coming;
 During Christmas, we celebrated Jesus' birth; and
 During Epiphany, God made it clear to us that Jesus is His Son, the Promised Messiah.
- b. This coming Wednesday Ash Wednesday, we will begin the Season of Lent:
 - i. Recalling our sins and our need for repentance!
 - Watching Jesus our God-Sent Champion †resist the devil's temptations and †demonstrate His power as He makes His way to the ULTIMATE FIGHT on Good Friday! Join us, benefit! (<u>BLC Lent Summary</u>)
