Text: Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43 NAS 1995

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Jesus told parables to challenge people to see <u>beyond physical things</u> to <u>spiritual</u> <u>things</u>. What is a parable? An easy-to-understand physical story, which has a much more important spiritual meaning.

During Jesus' ministry He told 55 parables (TLSB 1609).

Matthew chapter 13 records 8 of the 55. For all who are open to understand and be transformed [Isaiah 55:6], God the Father gives them understanding. For others, they hear but do not understand. Therefore, let us continue with penness, podly sorrow, and ptrust in Jesus!

1. The Parable of the Real Wheat and the Fake Wheat:

24 Jesus presented another parable to them, saying, "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a man who sowed good seed in his field. 25 But while his men were sleeping, his enemy came and sowed tares [fake wheat] among the [real] wheat, and went away. 26 But when the [real] wheat sprouted and bore grain, then the tares [fake wheat] became evident also. 27 The slaves of the landowner came and said to him, 'Sir, did you not sow good seed in your field? How then does it have tares [fake wheat]?' 28 And he said to them, 'An enemy has done

this!' The slaves said to him, 'Do you want us, then, to go and gather them up?' <sup>29</sup> But he said, 'No; for while you are gathering up the tares, you may uproot the wheat with them.' <sup>30</sup> 'Allow both to grow together until the harvest; and in the time of the harvest I will say to the reapers, "First gather up the <u>tares</u> [stalks of fake wheat] and bind them in bundles to burn them up; but gather the wheat into my barn.""

- a. Fake was put among the real (vv. 24-26):
  - i. The fake among the real helps us to understand the visible church on earth: The visible church includes those who SAY they are Christian or HAVE their name on a membership list. Among all such people, ©some know Jesus as Savior and Lord, and Some do not. The real Church is the invisible Church, since saving faith is invisible to us.
  - ii. <u>Jesus said to some in Sardis</u> (one of the 7 churches in Rev. 2-3): "...you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead" (3:1b NIV). Jesus knows everything!
  - iii. How to deal with the fake ones? We let them remain among us and we keep calling them to repent, <u>BUT</u> we do not permit their false beliefs to restrain us from telling God's saving truth!
- b. An enemy is the culprit (vv. 27-28a): Today, many congregations are in grave trouble because they have accepted fake teachings. The devil has done that through fake Christians.
- c. Rooting out the fake may harm the real (vv. 28b-29):

  The roots of the fake and real are intertwined like members of the same family, so we ▶let them remain and ▶keep calling them to repent.

- d. The separation will be made at the harvest (v. 30):

  Now, the fake claim to be real but the day of harvest will reveal the striking difference!
- 2. The Explanation of the Parable: <sup>36</sup> Then [Jesus] left the crowds and went into the house. And His disciples came to Him and said, "Explain to us the parable of the <u>tares</u> [fake wheat] of the field."
  - a. Who or what is represented? 37 And He said,
    - i. "The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man," – The Son of God in human flesh, JESUS!
    - ii. 38 "and the field is the world;" the entire earth!
    - iii. "and as for the good seed, these are the sons of the kingdom;" – Including all the people who ∮by grace, ∮through Spirit-worked sorrow and Spiritgiven faith, ∮trust in Jesus for eternal life!
    - iv. "and the <u>tares</u> [fake stalks of wheat] are the sons of the evil one;" – Such people:
      - 1. Do not acknowledge God or
      - 2. Do not have an interest in the word of God or
      - 3. Do not see their need for God or
      - 4. Do not know God's righteous requirement or
      - 5. Do not have godly sorrow or
      - 6. Do not embrace Jesus as Savior and Lord.
      - v. <sup>39</sup> "and the enemy who sowed them is the devil,"
         He is always trying to ruin our lives in Christ!
    - vi. "and the harvest is the end of the age;" When Jesus will return, and this fallen world will end!
    - vii. "and the reapers are angels." Holy angels!

- b. Eternal punishment for all the fake wheat: 40 "So just as the tares [fake stalks of wheat] are gathered up and burned with fire, so shall it be at the end of the age. 41 The Son of Man will send forth His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom
  - all stumbling blocks Literally, the trigger that traps an animal for the purpose of killing it. In other words: all who lead people away from Jesus.
  - ii. and those who commit lawlessness Whose lives are characterized by wickedness. NAS 1 John 3:8
     "...the one who practices sin is of the devil..."
  - <sup>42</sup> and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping [strong inner emotion] and gnashing of teeth [pain and anger]." // "And the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever" (Rev. 14:11).
- c. Eternal bliss for all the real wheat: <sup>43</sup> "Then THE RIGHTEOUS WILL SHINE FORTH AS THE SUN [Dan. 12:3] in the kingdom of their Father. // "[God] will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain" (Rev. 21:1).
- d. A final warning: **He who has ears, let him hear** [listen]."
