

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Today, as we continue in the Advent-Christmas booklet, we are beginning the section of Gospel passages that tell us about our Savior.

# Day 16 – Monday, 12/18 – The Word and Source of Life

**Read and Think**: John 1:1-5 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being. In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

### Answer and Pray:

- Who is "the Word" who was with God? The Word is the Son of God; He was with God before creation!
- What did "the Word" do in the beginning? The Word created all things out of nothing (Jn. 1:3; Rom. 4:17; Heb. 11:3).

Who is the source of your life? The Son of God: "In Him was life..." (Jn. 1:4); He gave us the gift of life!

# Day 17 – Tues, 12/19 – Mary's Son, the Son of the Most High

**Read and Think**: Luke 1:30-33 The angel [Gabriel] said to [Mary], "Do not be afraid, Mary; for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name Him Jesus [which means "the Lord saves"]. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David; and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and His kingdom will have no end."

### Answer and Pray:

- What does it mean that Mary "found favor with God"?
  - "The special grace on account of which the angel greets Mary is <u>God's selection of her</u> to be the mother of his Son (Lenski, 62)."
  - She is NOT special of herself, but because God chose to bring His Son into the world through her!
- Note the amazing realities of Mary's son:
  - "He will be great" the greatest of all!
  - **"the Son of the Most High"** the very Son of God wearing the human flesh of Mary!
  - "the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David" –
    - David ruled over the <u>earthly</u> nation of Israel over the <u>blood relatives</u> of Israel.

- Jesus is now ruling over the <u>eternal</u> nation of Israel

   over all the people who have <u>the faith</u> of Abraham,
   Isaac, and Jacob (Israel)!
- "He will reign over the house of Jacob forever" His kingdom is not temporal BUT <u>eternal</u>!

# Day 18 – Wed, 12/20 – Mary's Son, the Holy Son of God

**<u>Read and Think</u>: Luke 1:34-37** Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?" The angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; and for that reason the holy Child shall be called the Son of God. And behold, even your relative Elizabeth has also conceived a son in her old age; and she who was called barren is now in her sixth month. For nothing will be impossible with God." And Mary said, "Behold, the bondslave of the Lord; **may it be done to me according to your word**." And the angel departed from her.

### Answer and Pray:

- Nothing in the Bible indicates that Mary was holy, but the Bible makes it clear that her child would be holy.
  - <u>The RCC declares Mary to be holy</u> to explain Jesus being holy,<sup>1</sup> but they contradict God's word. The Bible says:
     **all have sinned** (Rom. 3:23) except Jesus (Heb. 4:15).
  - We let God be God and believe the Bible: In a way unknown to us, God, by the Holy Spirit, brought His holy Son into this world through Mary.

- With God it's possible: God <u>CAN</u> (He is almighty) and God <u>MUST</u> (He is holy) keep all His promises!
  - Elizabeth was pregnant *in her old age!*
  - Mary was pregnant *as a virgin!*
  - Mary became pregnant when she said, "may it be done to me according to your word"
- Are you fully open to God's will for your life? When we are saved through Jesus, we should be!
  - What made it **difficult** for Mary to say, "Yes"?
    - She was engaged, but not yet married!
    - Joseph would at least be very disappointed!
    - She would be mocked by her neighbors!
    - Being pregnant without being married, she could have been stoned to death (Lev. 20:10)!
  - O In the face of great difficulties, Mary said, "Yes!" Therefore, let us ♦be open to God's will for our lives and ♦honor Him by doing whatever He desires!

Let Us Pray: Dear Father, we are in awe: You made all things through Your Son, You even gave us life through Him!

Then, at the right time, Your Son put on Mary's flesh – to live and die and be raised for our salvation!

As Mary was open to Your will for her life, make us open to Your will for our lives!
